Father's Day: The first Father's Day observance was held on July 5, 1908, at Fairmont, West Virginia by Mrs. Charles (Grace) Clayton, who suggested to her pastor, Dr. Robert Thomas Webb at Williams Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church, South, that it would be wonderful if fathers were given a special day to be honored and remembered. The date closest to her father's birthday was chosen.

Two events seemed to have shaped her decision: First, the world's worst known mine explosion on December 6, 1907, at Monongah that killed more than 360 men, 210 of whom were fathers. 250 widows and more than 1,000 children were left grieving. Thoughts of these lonely persons touched Grace Clayton deeply. It was probably no coincidence that both Mrs. Clayton and Rev. Webb had lost two children each at birth or in early infancy. It has been estimated that over 100 children were killed in the mines. Second, the guidance and inspiration of her father, Rev. Fletcher Golden, a Methodist minister, influenced her.


