2017 Thanksgiving/Christmas Baskets & Angel Tree Summary

- Sponsored 33 families, including 76 children
- 5 Sunday School classes sponsored Food Baskets for 7 families (11 adults and 12 children). Included a \$25 Walmart gift card for meat for each holiday (\$350 total), paid out of Mission Outreach/Basket budget.
- Thanksgiving Baskets also included an Advent Devotional Book.
- Christmas Baskets included clothing and toys, 12 quilts made by the Young At Heart Quilters, and 12 Bibles — 10 purchased by the United Methodist Women (\$130) and 2 paid for by one Sunday School class.
- 64 additional children from 26 families were placed on the Angel Tree (1 Angel for clothing and 1 for toys, totaling 128 individual Angels). Special thanks to Debby Cunningham's Wednesday night class for cutting out the paper Angels!
- 9 additional Angel gifts were purchased through the Mission Outreach/Angel Tree budget (\$289) as well as through the donation of "L" dollars collected by the Stewards of Fellowship class (\$100).
- Budget was \$800; expenses were \$639.
- Hats, mittens, scarves, etc. were donated to Conner St. Elementary School.
